Haroon Khimani was an awardwinning contemporary, abstract artist with over forty years of experience. He was an international artist, having spent the past 15 years on his works across the U.S., India, and Dubai.

He received his degree in fine arts from the well-known M.S. University in Baroda, India in 1964. In the early years of his fine arts career, he focused on drawings and oil on canvas paintings inspired by natural or man-made calamities. His recent work uses a combination of acrylics and collage techniques.

Some of his recent accomplishments include citations awarded at the State Capitol in Boston, as well as a similar achievement from the governor of Rhode Island. His noteworthy exhibitions were at the Multicultural Art Center in Cambridge, Art League of Lowell, Brush Art Gallery in Lowell, Concord Art Gallery, and Jehangir Art Gallery in Mumbai, India.
