

# Films at Fowler (on Kanopy and Zoom)



## Films at Fowler continues in summer 2026 with **Location, Location, Location!**

For 26 years Concord film viewers gathered on winter evenings at Fowler Library to see some of the most interesting and stimulating examples of current and classic cinema from around the world. That movie series, now called **Films at Fowler**, changed to an online video streaming format in 2021 and continues in that format in 2026. Because we no longer meet in person, we now watch—on your own schedule—selected movies on Kanopy, a free streaming service available to Library patrons. We will then gather on Zoom on scheduled evenings for a lively movie discussion. The theme of the movies this summer is **Location, Location, Location**. The movies in this series are strongly reflective of and influenced by the environment and locale where the movie takes place. This poster shows the selected films on Kanopy and the discussion dates on Zoom.



**The Wedding Banquet** (1993). Director Ang Lee's breakout comedy about a gay Taiwanese immigrant in New York who marries a female artist to appease his traditional parents. Discussion date on Zoom: Wednesday June 10 at 7 p.m.

**Chinatown** (1974). John Huston's acclaimed noir set in 1930s Los Angeles where private eye Jake Gittes (Jack Nicholson) becomes entangled in conspiracy, corruption, and murder. Discussion date on Zoom: Wednesday June 24 at 7 p.m.

**Paris, je t'aime** (2007). An anthology film comprising 18 short segments set in different neighborhoods of Paris, each made by a different filmmaker exploring a unique facet of love. Discussion date on Zoom: Wednesday July 8 at 7 p.m.

**The Death of Stalin** (2018). A biting political satire that chronicles the chaotic power struggle among Soviet ministers following Joseph Stalin's sudden collapse and death in 1953. Discussion date on Zoom: Wednesday July 22 at 7 p.m.

**Up in the Air** (2009). George Clooney stars as a corporate "downsizer" who loves his nomadic life but becomes entangled in a budding romance with a fellow traveler. Discussion date on Zoom: Wednesday August 5 at 7 p.m.

**The Band Wagon** (1953). A classic MGM Technicolor musical comedy starring Fred Astaire as an aging Hollywood star who attempts to revive his career with a new Broadway musical. Discussion date on Zoom: Wednesday August 19 at 7 p.m.
