

Landscapes and Moonscapes

Landscapes and Moonscapes is an exhibit of charcoal drwaings by Maynard resident Cynthia Rodday and watercolor paintings by Groton resident Terry Durell. The exhibit at The Gallery of the Concord Free Public Library in Concord, MA, will be on display from June 1–29, 2013. The public is invited to view the works during regular library hours. A reception will be held from 2-4 p.m. on June 8, 2013.

Cynthia Rodday, a long-time resident of Maynard, will display her charcoal landscape drawings. Her previous digital mixed-media prints were exhibited at the River's Edge Arts Alliance, the Concord Art Association, the Beard Gallery at Wheaton College, Gallery 303 at Georgia Southern University and Umbrella Studio in Townsville, Australia. After a number of years working in digital mixed-media prints, she returned to charcoals in 2010 and has actively exhibited these drawings.

Terry Durell, a long-time resident of Groton, will display her watercolor paintings. Many people may know of Durell's botanical works she had exhibited throughout Massachusetts and New Hampshire, including exhibits at the Gleason and Groton Libraries, the Concord Art Association and Emerson Umbrella. The work she is displaying at the Concord Free Public Library will primarily be her moonscape paintings that were created using watercolor and mixed water media.
