Paint and More: Found Objects, Paper, Wood and Glass

The Concord Free Public Library will host a solo exhibition of work by Bedford artist Martha Brill from May 3 through May 30, 2014. There is an Artist's Reception on Saturday May 10 from 2:00 – 4:00.

The exhibit will feature 40 pieces including a painting and sculpture series, mixed media assemblages, diptychs and acrylic weavings. There are several three-dimensional sculptures based on the figure, including one larger than life which was created especially for this exhibition. In addition, recent works in glass will be on display.

Brill's work has a strong tactile quality with a sense of layers and surfaces. She has developed a distinctive way of creating art by combining found objects, painting and sculpture. The work is effective when viewed from a distance and rewarding when examined closely for the subtle details.

Martha Brill is a Bedford-based artist. She has exhibited painting, drawing, sculpture and installations in *The Creative Process* exhibits at the New Art Center, and in other group exhibitions at the DeCordova Museum School Gallery, the Grace Chapel Art Gallery, the Concord Art Association, the Falmouth Artist's Guild and the Bedford Public Library.
