Help Us Gather Knit/Crochet Items for the *Warm Hands* Project

Warm Hands was created as a Girl Scout Community Service Gold Award project. This is a project that Ambassador Girl Scouts embark upon if they wish - it requires a significant amount of community service and a singular focus.

After doing lots of research into the poor living conditions of many Syrians in refugee camps, Jules Struck decided to create a collaborative of people in the community (and the entire U.S.) to help out. Many Syrian refugees are in need of even the simplest things: food, shelter, warm clothing. This project targets one aspect of their needs.

All you have to do is knit, crochet, or sew clothing, blankets, mittens, etc. for the refugees. Then, you can add a short note of encouragement and well wishes to the Syrian who will receive your knitted item and put them in the donation basket near the library display. Items collect at the library and via the project website will be put in a larger package and mailed October 2015 to the Karam Foundation, who will hand out the items to refugees, particularly children, at the Al Salam School in Reyhanli, Turkey.
