

The Concord Free Public Library is pleased to offer its residents **Zinio Digital Magazines**, an online magazine service. It allows users to check out and download digital magazines to a home computer or mobile device. Enjoy unlimited checkouts with no waitlist or overdue fines!

1. Visit <http://concproxy.minlib.net/login?url=https://www.rbdigital.com/concordfreelibraryma/> to get started. First time users enter your library card # to be authenticated by the system first.

2. Click **Create New Account** in the upper right hand corner.

3. Enter your name, email address, and create a password to create your account.

4. Now you can browse through the magazine collection. Once you find a magazine you would like to read, tap or click on the cover to select it and then tap or click on **Checkout**.




5. Tap or click on **Keep Browsing** if you want to look for other magazines. To begin using the magazine tap or click on **Start Reading**.

6. You will now be directed to the Zinio website where you will be prompted to create an account. Once you have entered your information, tap or click **Register**. If you already have a Zinio account, tap or click on **Sign in Here**.

7. You should now see your **Reading List** with all of the magazines that you checked out. On most devices, you can tap or click on the cover of the magazine to open it and begin reading online. **\*Apple users will need to use the Zinio app as will any user who would like to download their magazines so that they can read while not connected to the Internet.**

8. To download the Zinio app, you can scroll to the bottom of your **Reading List** screen and click on the link for it or you can search in your device's app store.

9. Once you have downloaded the app, open it and tap on the **gear icon** in the lower right corner and log in to the app with the Zinio account information you created in step #6.

10. Tap or click on the **Read icon**  near the bottom of the screen to see your list of magazines. New titles will need to be

downloaded which you can do by tapping or clicking on the arrow icon on the cover of the magazine.



11. The magazine will automatically open to the cover so that you can begin reading. To exit, tap the center of the screen and then tap on the **X** in the upper left corner.

12. You may keep these magazines for as long as you like. They are yours. If you want to delete a magazine, just tap on **Edit** in the upper right corner. Tapping on the **x** in a **red circle** will delete the title. Tap **Done** in the upper right corner when you are finished.



## Frequently Asked Questions:

### ***What devices does Zinio work on?***

Android, Blackberry, iPad, iPhone, Nook HD/HD+, Kindle Fire/HD, Mac, PC, Mac, and Windows 8.

### ***Is Zinio a store? Do I need to pay for this service?***

Zinio does sell magazines and subscriptions. You can use your zinio.com account to buy magazines if you like, but nothing you check out from our collection will cost you any money. Just be sure to start at the link in step #1.

### ***I am an iPad user and got an Adobe Flash Player error message when trying to download Zinio Reader app. How can I solve the problem?***

Close your browser and open the Zinio app. Tap on the gear icon and log in with your Zinio account info to read your magazines.

### ***I've bought magazines from Zinio in the past. Can I use the same account to download library issues?***

If you use the same email address when you register for your account, you can use your existing Zinio account with it. If you do, your checked out magazines will appear alongside your purchased magazines in that account.

### ***I'm receiving promotional emails from Zinio. How do I stop them?***

Sign in to your account on the zinio.com site. Choose Preferences from the Account Settings menu on the left side of the screen. Change your email preferences to No and click Save Changes.

### ***Why do I need to create two new accounts?***

We buy our lendable subscriptions from one vendor (RBdigital) who manages your checkouts, but the digital files are provided by a second vendor (Zinio). Each company has a separate, secure login. Be sure to use the same email address for both accounts so your check outs from our collection can be communicated to Zinio.

### ***I'm still having trouble. Where can I find help?***
